### Weather.

Once again the weather has played a big part in our management this year. Reasonable rain fell during the first 3 months and below average rainfall was recorded up until August. We had several falls of snow during winter. Good Spring rain fell in October, replenishing all our dams.

### Fishing

We have had very positive feed back to our Fly Only fishing policy. Most anglers have welcomed the change and many new visitors are enjoying our Retreat.

Mainly smaller trout, up to 700gms were caught during the first few months, but as the year progressed the size of the fish increased and averaged about 900gms with the odd bigger trout (1.5 kg—4.4 kg) landed. With the wetter season there has been an incredible amount of insect activity. Lots of midge, white moth, flying ant, dragon fly and may fly. The flies that have had the most success were nymphs, caddis, midge, buzzers. During the winter months on bright sunny days, fishing from the dam wall with a sink-tip line and Olive Woolly Bugger worked well. English style wets had success when drifting from the rowboat. Fishermen also enjoyed superb midge hatches, with numerous fish moving into the shallows. Spring fishing proved exciting with trout taking almost any fly.

There is every indication that summer fishing should be the best we have seen for several years.

The Blue-billed Ducks continue to make their home at the main lake.
